The clerk showed proof of legal notice publishing. Supervisor Bentley opened the public hearing and announced that the 2010 Budget has no increase in taxes. There were no questions from those in attendance regarding the Budget.

The public hearing was closed at 6:10 PM.

The following Resolution was then introduced:

**RESOLUTION NO. 123 OF 2009**

Messrs. Olson & Dooris introduced Res. 123 and moved its adoption:

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE 2010 HORICON BUDGET**

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 5, 2009 at 6:00 PM at the Horicon Community Center on the Preliminary Budget for the year 2010, AND

WHEREAS, comments were invited from the public to speak for or against said budget, NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Preliminary Budget, as amended, will be the adopted budget for 2010, with the General Fund Appropriations of \$1,868,767.00 less anticipated revenues of \$1,475,700.00 and an unexpended balance of \$393,067.00 leaving an amount to be raised by taxes of -\$0-. Total Highway Fund Appropriations of \$1,258,814.00, less anticipated revenues of \$808,211.00 and an unexpended balance of -\$0-, leaving an amount to be raised by taxes of \$450,603.00 and a total budget of \$3,127,581.00, BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that the amount for the Horicon Fire District is \$217,973.00 to be raised by taxes and the Schroon Lake Park District is \$35,000.00.

Councilman Hill asked about safety equipment for Greg Hayes. It was agreed that he should be entitled to all the same safety equipment as the highway. Councilman Hill said he wants to see the men wearing the equipment the Town furnishes all the time instead of once in awhile.
